1. At 0247Z, Bullwhip 11 called Mayday in northern barrel roll. Tiger 02 intercepted and will attempt to escort Bullwhip 11 to Ch 70, Udorn RTAFB. Aircraft badly damaged. No instruments, no hydraulics.
2. Bullwhip 11 0257Z at fence with hole in canopy.
3. 0307Z, Bullwhip 11 left engine blew up both crewmembers bailed out on 032/20/70 among friendlies.
4. Pedros were sent to scene picked up both crewmembers, both physically OK, 0325Z.

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AIRCRAFT DESIGNATION: KING 3

DISTRESSED AIRCRAFT: BULLWHIP 11

LOCATION: 130/12/70

SAVES: 2

1. At 0245Z, King 3 was launched by Jack to support a mission King 1 was running (Boxer 24). King 3 was airborne at 0300Z. Before takeoff we were advised that a Bullwhip 11 was returning to Udorn with battle damage.
2. At 0303Z we heard Bullwhip 11 state that he was ejecting. He was escorted by Tiger 02. Tiger 02 reported Bullwhip's position as 130/12/70. He reported two good chutes.
3. King 3 established contact with Pedro 09, who was airborne, and directed him to the scene. At 0306Z, King 3 sighted both survivors in their chutes as they passed through 5000 ft. We gave Pedro 09 a DP steer to the area and directed Tiger 02 to maintain visual contact with one survivor, while we maintained visual contact with the other.
4. We had radio contact with both survivors before they hit the ground. Pedro 09 made the first pick up at 0315Z, the second at 0320Z. Both men were OK and taken to Udorn.
5. King 3 determined the location of the wreckage and then left the area to support King 1's mission.
6. Air refueling was not performed.
