1. (U) This report submitted IAW ARRSM 55-2/3 ARRGp Sup 1.
2. (S) On the evening of 20 Jan 70 the Tango crews for 21 Jan 70, JG 77L and JG 68H, were briefed on a first light to recover Sandy 04, an A-1 pilot who made a forced landing at LS 22, in the PDJ at 1110Z, 20 Jan 70. JG 77 and JG 68 departed Ch 70 at 202248, however JG 68 returned for maintenance and was replaced by JG 76. JG 76 joined JG 77 at 210020Z and both acft proceeded to the recovery area. On arrival, LS 22 was 150' overcast, tops 5000 with excellent visibility beneath the overcast. JG 77 found a hole in the overcast on route 74 approx 5 miles to the NE of LS 22. JG 77 descended VFR through the hole and proceeded along route 74 to LS 22. JG 77 landed on the runway, immediately picked up the survivor, and departed by the same route at 210140Z. Temp was 16°C, PA 3450'. The survivor was taken to LS 30 (also known as 98 and 20A) where he joined a 21 SOSq CH-3 departing for his home station, Ch 89. The mission was routine and unopposed.
