Summary of SAR Actions. 40 ARRSq was notified by 56th SOW Dispensary at 0900L of a need to medevac Air Force Sgt Misner, Thomas P., [REDACTED] who had internal bleeding to Udorn RTAFB. 3 ARRGp was notified of request and it was approved by JCKER. Jolly Green 30 was diverted from training sortie for medevac. Patient onloaded at 0940. Dr. Jerry W. Howington, FS, 249-60-3659 and four PJ's accompanied patient. Jolly Green 30 departed at 0955. Doctor advised pilot that helicopter should not exceed 5000 ft. Airspeed held at 85 knots to decrease the effect of turbulence. Landed at Udorn RTAFB at 1050L. Patient off-loaded to ambulance. Helicopter departed at 1235L for Camp Hunky to complete sling training.
