(USE ADDITIONAL PAGES IF REQUIRED) At 1215 local Pedro was notified by the 36th dispensary that two XEK VNAF personnel were severely burned when the aircraft they were working on caught fire. One crew light burns on his left shoulder, while the other had 1st, 2nd, and possibly 3rd degree burns over 75% of his body. Affected areas were his torso, lower arm, shoulders and lower back. When the aircraft first caught fire, the two men were in the aircraft. The mission was patient for emergency treatment at the 37th AFld Hospital. The mission was conducted without mishap.
