(USE ADDITIONAL PAGES IF REQUIRED) At 1215 local Pedro was notified by the 366th dispensary that two XEX VNAF personnel were severely burned when the aircraft they were working on caught fire. One had light burns on his arm and shoulder, while the other had 1st, 2nd, and possibly 3rd degree burns over 30% of his body. Affected areas were his trunk, legs, arms, shoulders and lower neck. Pedro was notified that immediate medical evacuation was required for the second patient for emergency treatment at the 95th Field Hospital. The mission was conducted without mishap.
