Claiming the shootdown of F-4E s.n. 69-0282 for the VPAF is Do Van Lanh, 921st Fighter Regiment, flying as a wingman in MiG-21MF s.n. 5128, employing a single R-3S Atoll heat-seeking A-A missile.

As a pilot of the elite 921st FR, Do Van Lanh (VPAF nickname/call sign "The Ironbird") scored four kills. His first was scored against an F-4 "Phantom" on May 20, 1972 over Phu Ly in a MiG-21. (Vietnamese News Agency)-
