The month of July has yielded seven more combat crewmembers that have been rescued by the men of the 37th ARRS. On July 5, 1972, Jolly Green 71 and 72 were terrain following over the South China Sea when without warning, two American F-4 crewmembers, the pilot; and navigator of Gaslight 01, were compelled to bail out somewhere over the drink. Hearing the distress call, both Jollies using precise navigation, proceeded at Warp Factor to the area. With clouds in the air and fish in the sea surrounding both survivors, Captains Mullenix and Tonn with their respective crews recovered two more grateful Americans. The lucky crews were:
