MAJOR, ROBERT B SWENCK - Aircraft Commander - Killed in action 25 November 1971. Major Swenck was born on 18 March 1933 in Louisville, Kentucky. He attended Grade and High School at Okaloma School in Louisville. He was a graduate of Western Kentucky State College and was commissioned in 1956 through the Reserve Officer Training Corps Program. Major Swenck earned his pilot's wings in January of 1957. Major Swenck's decorations include the Silver Star, the Distinguished Flying Cross with 1 OLC, the Airman's Medal, the Air Medal with 3 OLC, and the Air Force Commendation Medal. This was Major Swenck's second combat tour in Vietnam. He served in SEA previously, flying the Huey Gunship. He is survived by his wife Donna, and 3 daughters, who reside at 9509 Plumwood Road, Sainsville, Kentucky 40291.

CAPTAIN, JOHN W GEORGE - Copilot - Killed in action 25 November 1971. Captain George was born on 10 June 1945 in Dover, Tennessee. He attended Big Rock Elementary School in Big Rock, Tennessee and Stewart County High School in Dover. He was a graduate of the University of Tennessee in Knoxville and was commissioned in 1967 through the Reserve Officer Training Corps Program. Captain George earned his pilot's wings in February 1969 and this was his first tour in SEA. He is survived by his parents, Mr and Mrs Ray George, his wife Elizabeth and a daughter, who reside at P.O. Box 66, Big Rock, Tennessee 37023.

A1C THOMAS D PROSE - Pararescueman - Missing in action since 25 November 1971. Airman Prose was born on 9 April 1951 in Springfield, Illinois. He graduated from Girard High School in Girard, Illinois and attended Lincoln Community College in Springfield. Airman Prose entered Basic Training at Lackland AFB in March 1970. His decorations include the Air Medal with 1 OLC. He is survived by his Father, Lawrence E Prose and five brothers, who reside at RR # 2 Girard, Illinois 62640 and his Mother, Mrs. Jacqueline L. Epley.

SSgt JAMES R THOMAS - Pararescueman - Missing in action since 25 November 1971. SSgt Thomas was born on 5 July 1943 in Marianna, Florida. He attended grade school and High School in Florida and entered Basic Training at Lackland AFB in August 1963. SSgt Thomas's decorations include the Air Medal with 1 OLC and the Air Force Commendation Medal with 2 OLC. His wife Julia and 2 daughters reside at 406 Sherry Circle N.W., Fort Walton Beach, Florida.

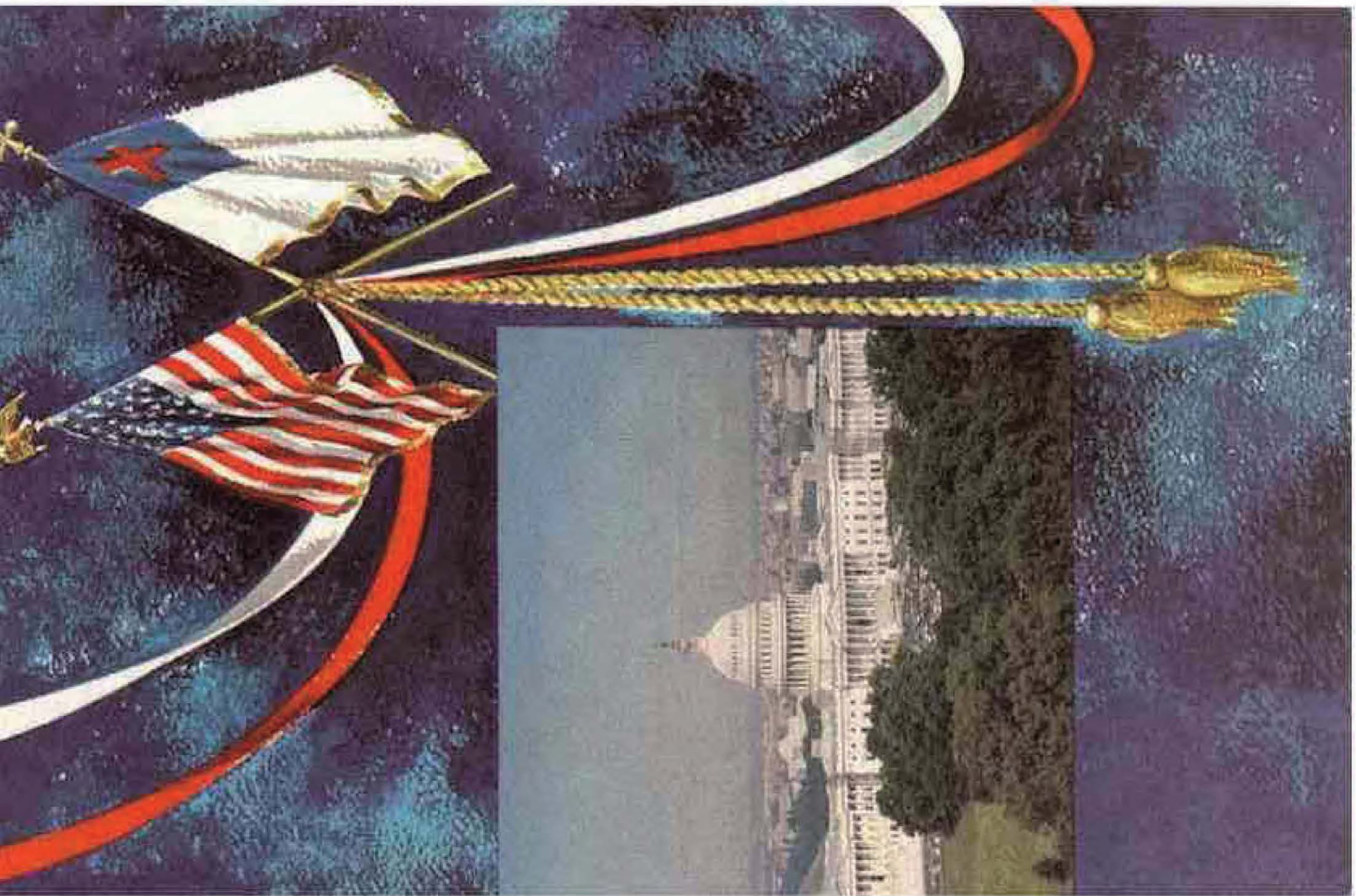

Capt Peter H. Chapman II - Aircraft Commander - Killed in action 6 April 1972, Vietnam. Capt Chapman was born on 26 August 1940 in Centerburg, Ohio, where he was raised and educated. He entered the Air Force in the early 1960's and completed navigator training. Soon after, Capt Chapman entered pilot training and recieved his wings in 1964. He flew the MAC line and C-141's until he transitioned into helicopters. This was Capt Chapman's first tour in SEA. He is survived by his parents, Mr and Mrs Peter H. Chapman, Route #2, Cantebury, Ohio, 43011.

1Lt John H. Call

1Lt John H. Call - Copilot - Killed in action 6 April 1972, Vietnam. Lt Call was born on 9 February 1947 in Washington, D. C. He was raised in Silver Springs, MD, and graduated from the University of Maryland in 1969. He entered the Air Force in 1970 and went through the Army helicopter training program at Ft. Walters and Ft. Amner. This was Lt Call's first tour in SEA. He is survived by his parents, Mr and Mrs John H. Call, 5 Greenland Court, Potomac, Maryland, 20854.

Sgt James Alley

Sgt James Alley - Combat Photographer - Killed in action 6 April 1972, Vietnam. Sgt Alley was born on 18 September 1949. His home is at Plantation, Florida and his last assignment was at Vandenburg AFB, California. Sgt Alley arrived in SEA during April 1971 and has been on flying status since he arrived. He has flown rescue missions with the Jolly Greens and was here to replace another sergeant who was slightly wounded by shrapnel. Sgt Alley had been stationed at Ubon Airfield, Thailand with the 40th ARRS and was at DaNang on TDY. He is survived by his parents and one sister.

TSgt Allen J. Avery

TSgt Allen J. Avery - Pararescueman - Killed in action 6 April 1972, Vietnam. TSgt Avery was born on 22 February 1943 in New York City, New York. He has been a pararescueman for about ten years. Sgt Avery's decorations include the Silver Star, Airmans Medal, Air Medal with 14 Oak Leaf Clusters, Air Force Commendation Medal, Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry with Palm. He is survived by his daughter Deborah K. Avery and his grandmother, Mrs. Sonia T. Avery, 56 Boyce Street, Auburn, Mass, 01501.

Sgt William R. Pearson

Sgt William R. Pearson - Pararescueman - Killed in action 6 April 1972, Vietnam. Sgt Pearson was born on 18 April 1951 in Concord New Hampshire. He entered the Air Force in 1970 and graduated from pararescue school in January 1971. This was Sgt Pearson's first tour in SEA where he flew on 116 combat missions. He is survived by his parents Mr. and Mrs. Robert P. Pearson, Rt #1, Warner, New Hampshire.

TSgt Roy D. Prater

TSgt Roy D. Prater, Flight Engineer, Killed in action 6 April 1972, Vietnam. TSgt Prater was born on 1 July 1936 in Knoxville, Tennessee. He entered the Marine Corps in the 1950's and flew the H-34 helicopter. He then joined the Air Force and flew the Jolly Greens since they began production. TSgt Prater is survived by his wife Carol J. Prater and their three children, Dennis, Debra and Pamela, Route #4, Columbia City, Indiana, 46725. He is also survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Donald S. Strickland, 118 Camelot Sub Division, Warner Robins, GA, 31093.
