Airman First Class John F. Tobey distinguished himself by meritorious achievement while participating in aerial flight as a Rescue Helicopter Pararescue Specialist in Southeast Asia on 17 September 1966. On that date, the successful rescue of a downed American pilot was accomplished, necessitating an open sea landing. Although the sea state **was** near the maximum limitations for the helicopter, the rescue was quickly and efficiently completed. The professional skill and airmanship displayed by Airman Tobey reflect great credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.
