TECHNICAL SERGEANT LAWRENCE WELLINGTON

Technical Sergeant Lawrence Wellington distinguished himself by heroism involving voluntary risk of life approximately 150 miles east of Tokyo, Japan, on 4-5 November 1968. On those dates, Sergeant Wellington parachuted into rough seas, on a dark nights and made his own way to a United States merchant *vessel* with medical equipment. He skillfully maneuvered *his* parachute to land about 40 feet from the ship, after which he treated a seriously burned patient. By his courageous action and humanitarian regard for his fellowman, Sergeant Wellington has reflected great credit upon himself and the United States Air Forces
