THE AIR FORCE COMMENDATION MEDAL

STAFF SERGEANT JACK A. BERGH

Staff Sergeant Jack A. Bergh distinguished himself by meritorious service as a Pararescue Specialist while assigned to Detachment 14, 39<sup>th</sup> Aerospace Rescue and Recovery Wing, Keflavik Naval Station, Iceland, from 1 August 1973 to 31 July 1975. During this period, Sergeant Bergh's knowledge, thoroughness and attention to detail were major factors in saving the lives of a Navy Petty Officer and a critically ill Icelandic woman as well as providing valuable assistance in several other rescue efforts. In performance of his additional duties, he effectively mastered the Air Force supply system to provide the section outstanding support, established comprehensive training programs and completed a resource conservation project valued at two thousand dollars. The distinctive accomplishments of Sergeant Bergh reflect credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.
