THE AIR FORCE COMMENDATION MEDAL
(FIRST OAK LEAF CLUSTER)

STAFF SERGEANT TERRY E. CAFFERY

Staff Sergeant Terry E. Caffery distinguished himself by outstanding achievement at Lower Russian Lake, Alaska, on the night of 29 May 1978. On that date, Sergeant Caffery permitted himself to be lowered 125 feet through dense trees to a gravely injured survivor. He administered the necessary emergency medical treatment resulting in the saving of the young man's life. By his prompt action and humanitarian regard for his fellow man, Sergeant Caffery has reflected credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.

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
