THE AIR FORCE COMMENDATION MEDAL

AIRMAN FIRST CLASS ERIC L. GREGORY

Airman First Class Eric L. Gregory distinguished himself by outstanding achievement on 9 November 1970 while assigned as a Pararescue Technician 79th Aerospace Rescue and Recovery Squadron, Anderson Air Force Base, Guam. On that date, Airman Gregory was a member of the Pararescue Team which parachuted to a Liberian Flagship, the Dona Maria, to render medical treatment to a critically wounded seaman. Airman Gregory expertly administered medical treatment, to the patient, until he was evacuated by helicopter. Airman Gregory is credited by professional medical personnel in being highly instrumental in saving the patients life. By his prompt professional ability, and humanitarian regard for his fellow man, Airman Gregory has reflected credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.
