STAFF SERGEANT CHARLES W. WALLS

Staff Sergeant Charles W. Walls distinguished himself by outstanding achievement at the Chamonix-Mount Blanc area of France on 27 August 1982. On that date, Sergeant Walls participated in the rescue and evacuation of two individuals trapped 300 feet from the summit of the mountain. The individuals were suffering from hypothermia, and only the outstanding medical knowledge of Sergeant Walls allowed for their safe recovery. By his action and humanitarian regard for his fellowman, Sergeant Walls has reflected credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.
