Sergeant Charles D. Morrow distinguished himself by extraordinary achievement while participating in aerial flight as an HH-3 rescue helicopter Pararescue Specialist in Southeast Asia on 2 December 1969. On that date, Sergeant Morrow effected a difficult night rescue of a downed United States Air Force pilot. Sergeant Morrow's explicit instructions enabled his aircraft commander to establish a precise hover above the survivor as Sergeant Morrow, utilizing only the helicopter's limited illumination, skillfully accomplished the difficult recovery. The professional competence, aerial skill and devotion to duty displayed by Sergeant Morrow reflect great credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.
