

CITATION TO ACCOMPANY THE AWARD OF

THE DISTINGUISHED FLYING CROSS

TO

SERGEANT CHARLES D. MORROW

Sergeant Charles D. Morrow distinguished himself by heroism while participating in aerial flight as a Pararescue Specialist in Southeast Asia on 7 February 1970. On that date, Sergeant Morrow, a crew member aboard an HH-3E rescue helicopter, penetrated an extremely hostile area to successfully rescue two downed United States Navy pilots. Disregarding the threat of antiaircraft and automatic weapons fire, Sergeant Morrow elected to attempt the rescue, and protecting his vulnerable aircraft with only, a hand-held weapon, assisted in the location and recovery of each pilot. The outstanding heroism and selfless devotion to duty displayed by Sergeant Morrow reflect great credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.
